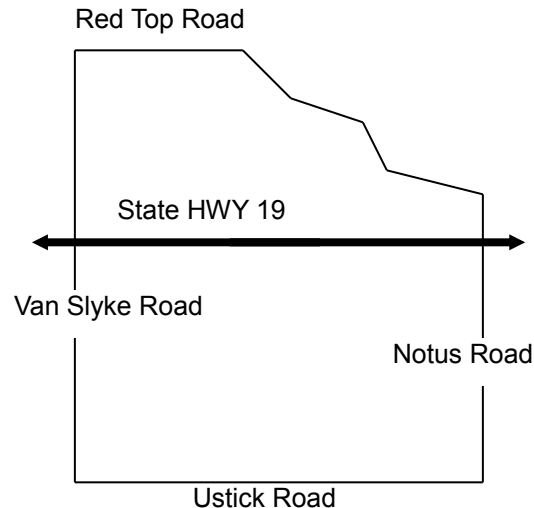

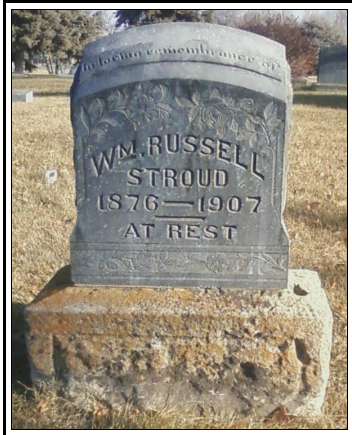

A Brief History...

1907 minutes of Mountain View Monthly Meeting (which became Greenleaf Friends Church) record that a committee was formed to find a suitable resting place for settlers in the Greenleaf area. Two acres in the southeast corner of the Osborn homestead were selected.

Before the land could be surveyed and platted into lots, Russell Stroud died in December of 1907 and was buried on the site. The committee asked that the area be surveyed in 1909, but weather prevented the survey until 1910.



Greenleaf Friends Church purchased the property in 1911, and on Arbor Day of that year 75 trees were planted on the site.

The Church operated the cemetery until the financial burden of doing so became to great. In 1942 Idaho Governor Chase Clark appointed Commissioners and the Greenleaf Cemetery Maintenance district was formed.

Guidelines...

- Headstones will not be placed until the lot is paid in full
- New headstones are not to be over two feet tall, as the sprinkler system will not effectively irrigate over taller headstones
- Only Greenleaf Cemetery District maintenance personnel are authorized to dig graves, including cremation graves
- Saturday or Holiday burials are at an additional cost, and are only scheduled in the morning
- Planting of bushes, trees, bulb flowers and other vegetation is **NOT** allowed without permission
- Flowers and decorations will be removed as needed by maintenance personnel
- **NO ALCOHOL** is allowed on Cemetery property
