History in the Making...



The Greenleaf Historical Society is seeking your help to maintain restoration of the little school house that sits in back of the Greenleaf Cemetery. Your help is also needed to build the museum collection stored in this historic building, to preserve the community's history.

When the rural Canyon County school districts consolidated into the Vallivue School District, this building was moved to the Midway School near Nampa. Now, it has been given to the Greenleaf Historical Society and returned to the community.

This was a one-room school house for grades 1-8, later housing grades 1&2. It was built in 1928-29 for Greenleaf School District #44, where many in the community, or their parents, attended school.
