### District 44 Schoolhouse



When the rural Canyon County school districts consolidated into the Vallivue School District, this building was moved to the Midway School near Nampa. Now, it has been given to the Greenleaf Historical Society and returned to the community. Its last move was from the Greenleaf Cemetery. Currently located near the intersection of Highway 19 and Friends Road in Greenleaf, Idaho.

This was a one-room school house for grades 1<sup>st</sup> & 2nd. It was built in 1928-29 for Greenleaf School District #44, where many in the community, or their parents, attended school.
